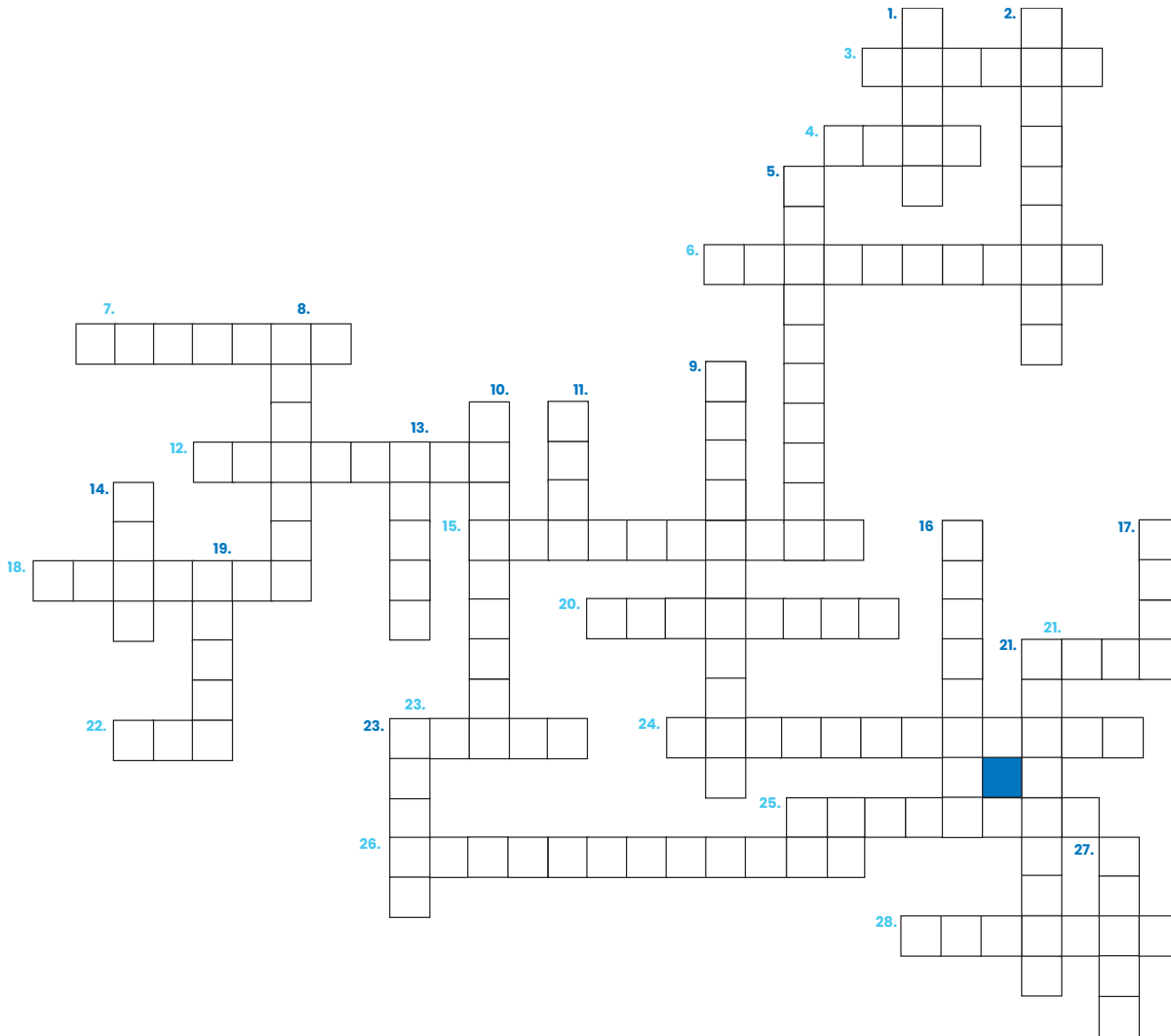


# National Service Dog Month Crossword Puzzle



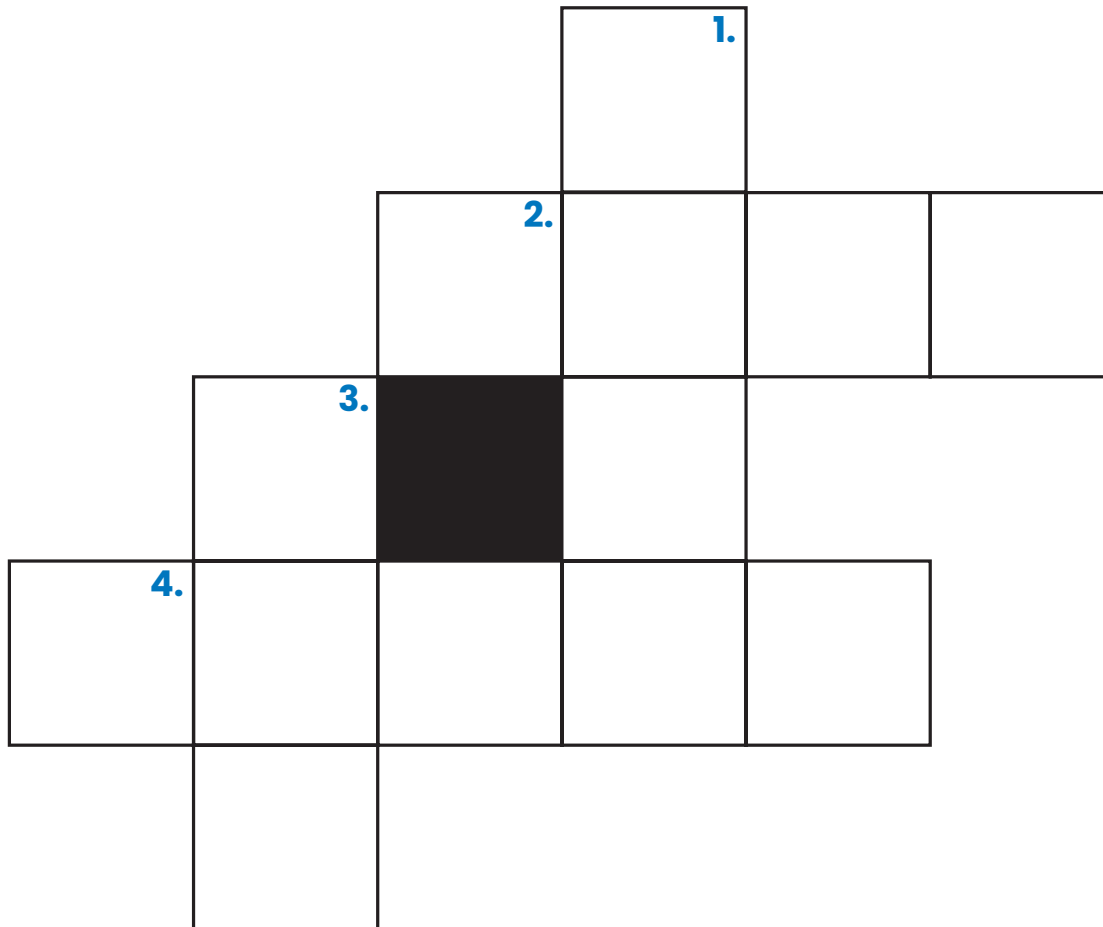
